What is the YIG Program?

The Washburn County Board of Supervisors welcomes youth in grades 9, 10, and 11 that live in Washburn County and/or attend school in Washburn County to apply to serve as youth representatives on the County Board and Committees.

This initiative provides youth an opportunity to play a valuable and active leadership role in the governance of the county, while enhancing their interest in the operation of local government and civic participation. Youth board members will receive \$50 for attending and participating in meetings. Youth will serve for one term (April 2025 - March 2026).

Expectations of Youth Representatives

- Attend monthly county board meetings at the Washburn County Government Center in Shell Lake, WI. Meetings are the third Tuesday every month at 6:00 pm.
- Stay informed about county board issues. Be prepared for meetings; obtain and review materials prior to meeting
- Attend bimonthly YIG cohort education meetings, which provide a space to connect with other youth representatives
