When: Sunday, March 30th 2:00 pm

Where: Shell Lake High School Commons

Registration deadline: March 15th

Why: This event is about learning practical life skills, like feeding and clothing ourselves and others. The Foods Revue is different from the fair! At the fair, we showcase baked goods. **Foods Revue focuses on practical, everyday meals, like casseroles or soups and live cooking demonstrations.** The Clothing Revue is different from the fair! At the Fair, we showcase how items are sewn. **Clothing Revue focuses on how the outfit (sewn or purchased) fits and looks on the exhibitor.** Sewing skills are not required for Clothing Revue as there is a Purchased Clothing option.
