

4-H Act in a Sack Judging Sheet

A team of two to four youth receive a sack of props for an act and have 10 minutes to organize a 5 minute act or play. The Act should have:

1. A situation and characters whose meanings are clear to the audience.
2. There must be a problem or conflict for the characters to solve (this is what makes a drama)
3. The characters must actively show, not tell, the events of the story.
